The Transportation Communications International Union – Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority Health & Welfare Fund's **Annual Open Enrollment Period** has commenced. During open enrollment, eligible participants may change their medical, dental, and/or vision plan(s), as well as enroll or disenroll their eligible dependents.

If you do not wish to change your current medical, dental, and/or vision plan(s) or to enroll or disenroll a dependent, no action is required. Your coverage will continue under your current plans, provided that you continue to be eligible and make the required participant contributions.

After open enrollment ends, you will not be permitted to change your selections until the next Annual Open Enrollment Period in November 2020, unless you qualify for Special Enrollment Rights. See page 6, § II(A.)(9) of the Fund's Summary Plan Description for a discussion of the limited right to enroll or switch plans mid-year.

Effective January 1, 2020, your choices of medical, dental, and vision plans are as follows:

Medical Plan Options

- Indemnity Medical Plan
- Kaiser Permanente – HMO
- United HealthCare – HMO

Dental Plans Options

- Indemnity Dental Plan
(First Dental Health)
- United Concordia Dental

Vision Plan Options (Indemnity Plan and United HealthCare HMO Enrollees)*

- VSP – Access Indemnity
- VSP - HMO

***Kaiser enrollees are required to receive their vision benefits through Kaiser.**

(Under Kaiser's enhanced vision benefits, each Kaiser enrollee has a \$200 allowance towards either frames or contact lenses available once every 12 months. Basic lenses (single vision or bifocal) and anti-reflective coating are included at no cost every 12 months. Effective June 1, 2018, tinting on covered lenses is also included at no cost. You can upgrade to basic progressive lenses at no additional cost, by consulting with your Kaiser optician.

A description of each of these plans can be found on the Fund's **website** @ www.tcu-mtawelfare.org. Please note that you are permitted to opt-out of dental and/or vision coverage for yourself and your dependents. However, doing so will not reduce the amount of your participant contributions.

If you are interested in changing your current medical, dental, and/or vision enrollment, you may request additional information about the plans and can receive an enrollment form for any of the above plans by calling the Administrative Office at (800) 427-5342 or (562) 463-5090. If you choose to change your current medical, dental, and/or vision plan(s) or enroll a dependent, you must complete and mail the appropriate enrollment form to the Administrative Office before **December 6, 2019**. If you timely submit your enrollment form(s) by December 6, 2019, your changes will be effective January 1, 2019.
